

Serbian Prize of Logic

Call for Applications 2021

Members of the Serbian academic community whose research is in logic or any topic related to logic, according to the standards of the international logic community, are invited to apply for the Serbian Prize of Logic for 2021.

1) We invite contenders to submit an unpublished original manuscript written in English, between 10 and 30 pages long.

2) Contenders should be researchers whose career spans less than 10 years since their PhD/doctorate or researchers whose 40th birthday does not occur before 2021. Contenders should be affiliated with a Serbian academic institution. In case of co-authorship, each author is to fulfil these conditions.

3) The award-winning paper will be published in the highly ranked journal *Logica Universalis* (Springer, Birkhäuser). The paper will be presented at the UNILOG 2022 congress, 6–11 April 2022, in Kolymvari, Crete, Greece. Travel costs will be covered by the Serbian organizers, whereas the accommodation and congress fee will be provided by UNILOG. This support is awarded to the author or one of the co-authors of the winning paper.

4) Deadline for paper submission is 6 December 2021.
